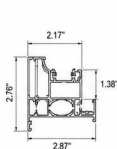




INSTALLATION DETAIL

ROUGH OPENING:

Door Dimensions will be exactly your door size with a frame.
Recommended rough opening is between 3/4" (19mm) – 1" (25mm) larger than the Door width and height.
Ensure that the rough opening is plumb, level and square, and the walls in the opening are not twisted.



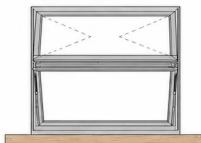

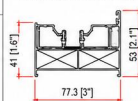

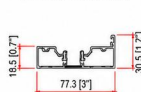


BOTTOM TRACK OPTIONS
